
Neshat's "film within a film" tells the story of an Iranian director by the name of Mitra who embarks on her dream project of making a film about the legendary Egyptian singer and diva Oum Kulthum. But as she explores the issues faced by Oum Kulthum as a female artist in a male-dominated society, Mitra's own struggles blend with those of the singer as she finds herself heading for a breakdown.

Commenting on the film, Neshat says: For the past twenty years, as a visual artist and a filmmaker, I have explored diverse concepts and narratives in relation to Muslim women. In 2009, I directed my first feature film 'Women Without Men,' based on a magical realist novel written by the Iranian female author, Shahrnush Parsipur."

"Continuing with my obsession with female strength and artistic expression in the Muslim world, since 2010, I have been developing my next feature film project based on the art and life of the legendary Egyptian singer Oum Kulthum (1900–1975), whose music and larger-than-life persona has and continues to be embedded in the hearts and imaginations of millions of Middle Easterners,"
